### CLEP Tests

CLEP (College Level Exam Placement) examinations cover material taught in courses that most students take as requirements in the first two years of college. These tests each cost \$120, but can be worth three or more college credits. Check with your schools to see if they accept CLEP exams (not all schools do accept them) or use this online tool [http://apps.collegeboard.com/cbsearch\\_clep/searchCLEPColleges.jsp](http://apps.collegeboard.com/cbsearch_clep/searchCLEPColleges.jsp)
